ACTION REQUESTED OF THE BOARD OF ESTIMATES:

Authorization is requested from your Honorable Board to provide a stipend of \$2,000 to employees in the class of Fuel Systems Specialist in the Department of General Services, Fleet Management Division.

AMOUNT AND SOURCE OF MONEY:

Funds are available in budget account number: 2030-000000-1890-189300-603026.

BACKGROUND AND EXPLANATION:

The Office of the Labor Commissioner has met with the Department of General Services, Fleet Management to discuss incentives for employees in the class of Fuel Systems Specialist. Employees who obtain, and as long as they retain a Commercial Driver's License (CDL), shall receive an annual stipend of \$2,000 to be paid biweekly. By providing this stipend, management of Fleet Services would have less reliance on vendors to move its equipment. The employees, who obtain CDLs in the class listed above, will receive the additional compensation for as long as the licenses are maintained.
